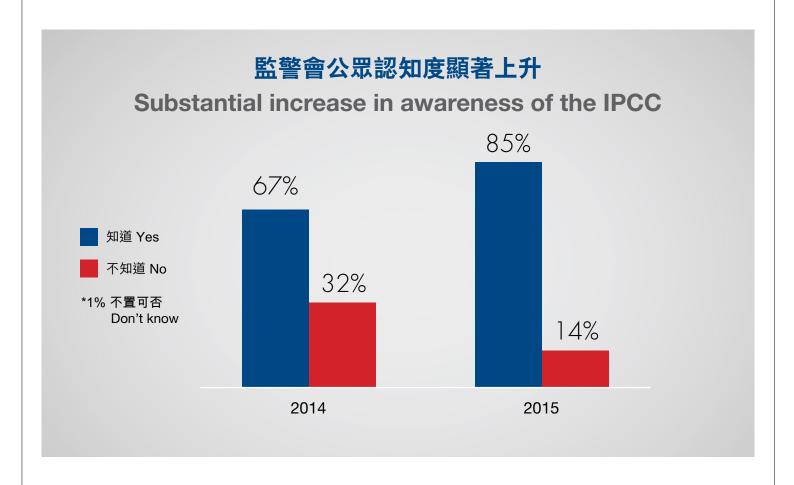

調查顯示市民對監警會的認知度顯著上升

Survey shows substantial increase in public awareness of the IPCC

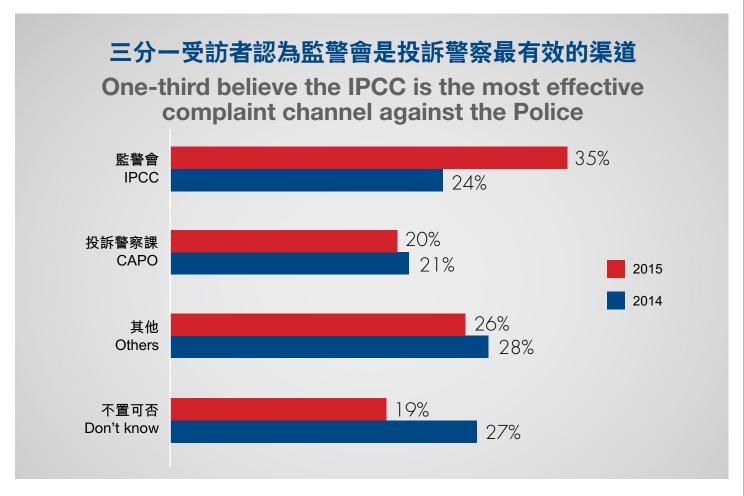
公眾意見調查是近年監警會用作評估公眾對監警會的認識的一個重要指標。自監警會在2009年正式成為獨立的法定機構後,監警會便要履行《監警會條例》第8條(1)(e)賦予的法定職能一「加強公眾對監警會的角色的認識。」。調查結果有助會方擬定宣傳方向,以便有效履行《監警會條例》第8條(1)(e)。

在2009年6月1日《監警會條例》正式生效,投訴警方獨立監察委員會(警監會)改稱為獨立監察警方處理投訴委員會(監警會),監警會於同日成為法定機構,會方在2009年3月及2010年3月分別進行了兩次民意調查,希望藉此比較公眾分別對警監會及監警會的認知及觀感。調查結果為會方計劃往後幾年的對外傳訊工作提供了重要的資訊。

Public opinion surveys have proved an important tool in assessing the public's perception of the IPCC in recent years. Survey results have helped shape the IPCC's publicity initiatives since it became a statutory body in 2009, enabling the IPCC to effectively discharge its statutory duty, set out in section 8(1)(e) of the IPCC Ordinance (IPCCO), "to promote public awareness of the role of the Council".

When the IPCC became a statutory body on 1 June 2009, the first two public opinion surveys were carried out in March 2009 and March 2010 to measure the shift in public perceptions between the pre-and post-statutory IPCC. The results provided valuable information that helped the IPCC plan its publicity initiatives in the following years.

監警會在2013及2014年委任了香港大學民意研究計劃進行公眾意見調查,藉此評估對外傳訊工作的成效,以及大眾對監警會及其職能的認知度。調查結果有助會方識別各種有效加強公眾對監警會的認識的渠道。公眾意見調查在2015年繼續進行,部分問題因應去年的佔領事件作出了調整。這次調查於2015年3月3日至3月13日期間,以隨機抽樣電話訪問的形式進行,並成功訪問了1,014位18歲或以上的香港居民。

為了可以更有效追蹤過往數年公眾對監警會的觀感,意見調查中的部分問題沿用2009年及2010年問卷內的問題。此外,亦有些問題會因應該年度的重大事件作出調整,以便量度這些事件對會方的影響。

本年度的公眾意見調查發現,公眾對監警會的認知度有顯著上升,今年整體受訪者中,曾聽過監警會的佔85%,較去年的67%,錄得18%的增幅。表示聽過監警會的受訪者當中,近一半人能夠正確地指出監警會至少一項職能,相較去年上升了9%。

In 2013 and 2014 the IPCC commissioned the University of Hong Kong's Public Opinion Programme (HKUPOP) to conduct additional surveys to assess the effectiveness of its publicity initiatives and to track public awareness of the IPCC and its duties. The results helped the IPCC identify different channels to enhance public understanding of the Council. This survey continued in 2015, and in view of the Occupy Movement last year, some questions were modified to measure the impact of the Occupy Movement on complaints against the Police. The survey was conducted by telephone interviewers on a random sample, from 3 March to 13 March 2015. There were 1,014 successful interviews with Hong Kong residents aged 18 or above.

To better track changes in public perception of the IPCC over the years, some survey questions are derived from the questionnaire used in 2009 and 2010. Some questions are modified yearly to measure the impact of significant events that occurred in the past year.

The highlight of this year's public opinion survey results was the significant increase in public awareness of the IPCC, with 85% of respondents indicating that they had heard of the Independent Police Complaints Council or IPCC. This is a substantial increase of 18%, compared with last year's 67%. Among those who had heard of the IPCC, almost half could correctly identify at least one of the IPCC's duties, representing an increase of 9% over last year.

與此同時,95%曾聽過監警會的受訪者表示電視是他們認識監警會的主要途徑。另一項值得留意的是,從互聯網得知監警會的人數錄得明顯升幅,由去年的22%升至本年的33%。

為了回應這個趨勢,監警會不遺餘力地優化各種網上溝通渠道,例如推出新網站及開拓各種社交媒體。此外,由於電視是公眾認識監警會的主要途徑,監警會與香港電台聯合製作全新一輯電視劇集《監警有道》,於2015年5月至6月期間播映。該劇由一連八集半小時的單元劇組成,於國時段播出,是會方為了加強公眾對監警會兩層架構投訴警察制度的了解而推行的宣傳項目,以履行《監警會條例》中第8條(1)(e)的職能。

這次調查的另一要點是有35%的受訪者認為監警會是投訴警察最有效的渠道,較去年的24%有明顯升幅。相反,僅兩成受訪者指出投訴警察課是最有效的投訴渠道。雖然向投訴警察課投訴(而非向監警會投訴)才是正確的方法,但上述結果反映市民對監警會及其監察角色有一定的信心。

調查結果顯示有更多市民了解監警會的獨立性質,當中67%受訪者能夠正確地指出「監警會是獨立於警察部門的機構」,較2014年的63%,同樣錄得增幅。

While 95% of respondents indicated that television was the main medium through which they had heard about the IPCC, it is worth noting that there was also an evident increase in the number of people who had learned about the IPCC via the Internet; 33% of respondents indicated this channel, compared with 22% last year.

In response to this trend, the IPCC has dedicated extensive effort to improving its online communication channels, such as revamping the IPCC website and exploring social media initiatives. In continuing to leverage television as the main communication channel with the public, a new TV drama series, *IPCC Files*, was produced in collaboration with RTHK and aired from May through June 2015. The TV series, comprised of eight half-hour episodes and was broadcast during prime time, is a key communication initiative to enhance public understanding of how the IPCC and the two-tier police complaints system operates, which is the ultimate goal in carrying out the IPCC's function in section 8(1)(e) of the IPCCO.

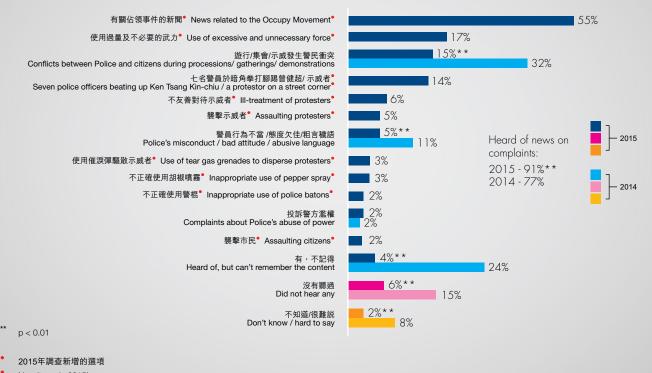
Another highlight of this year's survey results is that 35% of respondents said they considered the IPCC the most effective channel to lodge a complaint against the Police, a significant increase from last year's 24%. Only 20% indicated that the Complaints Against Police Office (CAPO) is the most effective channel. Although the correct channel for lodging complaints is CAPO, rather than the IPCC, these results suggest that the public tends to trust the IPCC and its monitoring role.

The survey results also showed that more people are aware of the IPCC's independent status, with 67% of respondents correctly answering that "the IPCC is a totally independent organisation, not under the Police", an increase from 63% in 2014.

本年度的公眾意見調查亦反映公眾對投訴警察的 認知顯著上升,91%受訪者表示於去年曾聽聞有 關投訴警務人員的新聞,較去年的77%為多。超 過一半受訪者表示他們聽聞有關投訴警務人員的 新聞是和佔領事件有關。

最後,對監警會的期望方面,多於三分一的受訪 者希望會方以公平、公正、具高透明度的方式處 理投訴個案。會方會繼續積極履行其法定職能, 維持獨立、公正及誠信的核心價值觀。

監警會公眾認知度顯著上升令人鼓舞,顯示會方 履行《監警會條例》第8條(1)(e)的成果。然而, 機構仍有不少進步的空間,會方將繼續透過各方 面工作改善機構整體形象,以及增加公眾對監警 會職能的認識。

This year's survey also revealed a substantial increase in public awareness of police complaints, with 91% of respondents stating that they had heard news of complaints lodged against the Hong Kong Police Force in the past year, compared with 77% from last year. Over half of the respondents indicated that the news they heard about police complaints was related to the Occupy Movement.

Lastly, in terms of public expectations of the IPCC, over one-third of respondents said they hoped the IPCC would handle cases in a fair, impartial and transparent manner. To this end, the IPCC will endeavour to assure the public that the Council will continue to diligently discharge its statutory duties and uphold its core values of independence, impartiality and integrity.

Overall, the significant increase in public awareness of the IPCC is encouraging news with regard to the IPCC's statutory duty in section 8(1)(e). Nevertheless, there is always room for improvement, and more work needs to be done to improve the IPCC's overall image and to better explain the IPCC's duties to the general public.

IPCC Files kicks off with publicity campaigns Full series now available online

為履行《監警會條例》第8條(1)(e)的職能,監警會成為法定機構後,積極加強對外傳訊工作,從而增加公眾對監警會和投訴警察制度的認識。因此,會方繼2012年後再度與香港電台合作,聯合製作每集30分鐘的電視劇集《監警有道》,故事內容由真實投訴個案改編。

經過長達一年的籌備及拍攝,一連八集的《監警有道》終於在2015年5月5日至6月23日在港台電視31及無線電視翡翠台正式播映。為了讓更多市民認識新一輯《監警有道》,會方在劇集播映期間展開了一系列宣傳活動,包括在全港各個港鐵站內擺放燈箱廣告以及在九龍塘港鐵站的當眼處

Since becoming a statutory body, the IPCC has proactively discharged its duty, as set out in section 8(1)(e) of the IPCC Ordinance (IPCCO), to promote public awareness of the Council and understanding of the police complaints system. To this end, following collaboration in 2012, the IPCC once again joined efforts with RTHK in the production of a brand new TV series, *IPCC Files*, with 30-minute episodes adapted from actual complaint cases.

After a year of preparation and filming, the eight-episode series *IPCC Files* was aired from 5 May till 23 June 2015 on RTHK TV 31 and TVB Jade. To promote the new series of *IPCC Files*, an advertising campaign was launched during the broadcasting period, which included MTR 4-sheet panels and a power banner at Kowloon Tong station with the embedded 103" HDTV playing a one-minute trailer. Highlights of the series were also shown on plasma TV rings

設置巨型橫額,更於附設的103吋高清電視播放長達 1分鐘的劇集預告片。除了平面廣告,會方亦安排在 沙田、上水及旺角東三個港鐵站內的等離子電視圈播 放劇集的精華片段,讓市民先睹為快。此外,新巴及 城巴車廂內的電視亦有播放《監警有道》的製作 輯,披露一眾演員飾演監警會委員及審核主任的體 和拍攝花絮。監警會同時在不同的網上平台設置橫額 廣告,例如YouTube、新聞網站以及各大網上討論區 等,預計曝光率可達700萬次。劇集於YouTube監警 會頻道上宣傳,而劇中演員的Facebook專頁亦可 到有關劇集的消息,都市日報則刊登《監警有道》首 四集的專題文章,讓讀者率先了解劇集詳情。劇集 傳海報分別張貼於全港各區警署報案室、中學、圖書 館、公共屋邨及民政事務署。

在5月4日,即新一輯《監警有道》播映的前一天,香港電台舉行了《監警有道》啟播禮,一眾監警會委員均應邀出席。出席者包括郭琳廣主席、副主席張華峰議員、宣傳及意見調查委員會主席鄭承隆先生、陳建光醫生、劉玉娟女士、梁繼昌議員、杜國鎏先生、陳建強醫生、何世傑博士、劉文文女士、蘇麗珍女士、何錦榮先生及關治平工程師。一眾觀察員及投訴警察課代表亦到場支持,場面熱鬧。助理廣播處長陳敏娟女士代表香港電台致辭,並與郭琳廣主席及鄭承隆先生主禮啟播儀式,為劇集掀開序幕。郭琳廣主席

Moreover, *The Making of IPCC Files* clip was shown on in-bus TVs aboard New Bus and Citybus, in which actors shared their thoughts on playing the roles of Council Members and vetting officers. The IPCC also placed online banner ads on various online platforms such as YouTube, news web sites and popular discussion forums, with an estimated number of impressions of around 7 million. The series was promoted on the IPCC YouTube channel, by celebrities on their Facebook fan pages and on Metro Daily, which published feature articles on the first four episodes. Promotional posters were displayed at police report rooms, secondary schools, public libraries, public estates and Home Affairs Department Community Centres.

On 4 May, the day before IPCC Files officially aired, RTHK organised a launch ceremony for IPCC Files. Attending Members included Mr Larry Kwok Lam-kwong (Chairman), Hon Chris Cheung Wah-fung (Vice-Chairman), Mr Edwin Cheng Shing-lung (Chairman of the Publicity and Survey Committee), Dr Chan Pui-kwong, Ms Noeline Lau Yuk-kuen, Hon Kenneth Leung Kai-cheong, Mr Clement Tao Kwok-lau, Dr Eugene Chan Kin-keung, Ir Dr Vincent Simon Ho, Miss Lisa Lau Man-man, Ms Ann So Lai-chun, Mr Richard Ho Kamwing and Ir Edgar Kwan Chi-ping. IPCC Observers and CAPO representatives also attended the ceremony to show their support. Ms Chan Man-kuen (Assistant Director of Broadcasting, RTHK) hosted the officiating ceremony with Mr Larry Kwok Lam-kwong and Mr Edwin Cheng Shing-lung. Mr Larry Kwok Lam-kwong delivered a speech on how the drama illustrates the statutory functions of the IPCC. He also thanked RTHK for their dedication and professionalism and CAPO for their technical guidance

網站主頁設有五張自動轉換的滑動橫額,瀏覽者可看到監警會最新活動資訊,包括新一輯電視劇《監警有道》。瀏覽者在點擊橫額後,便會連結到相關的資訊。主頁上四個主要訊息圖標讓瀏覽者方便快捷地連結到監警會的重要資料,例如投訴警察制度的兩層架構、監警會年報及常見問題等。

最新一期的季刊《監警會通訊》亦會在主頁上展示,讓瀏覽者更容易掌握監警會的最新動態。有別於過去必須下載整份《監警會通訊》的安排才能閱讀通訊內容,瀏覽者現在可以在新網站按需要下載《監警會通訊》的個別章節。監警會年報的網上版亦採用同樣方式,可按內容章節分別下載。

The website is designed to attract visitors to browse its different sections, with easier navigation through better categorisation of materials, and to showcase the IPCC's social media capacity through the embedded YouTube player.

Visitors can view snapshots of the IPCC's latest activities, such as episodes from the TV drama series *IPCC Files*, through five major banners that rotate automatically on the home page. Clicking the banner leads the visitor to more detailed information. Four main icons offer quick and easy access to essential information about the IPCC, such as the two-tier police complaints system, the IPCC annual reports, frequently asked questions etc.

The latest issue of the IPCC's quarterly newsletter is also featured on the home page, enabling visitors to keep up to date with the IPCC's activities. The newsletter can now be downloaded by section instead of having to download the whole publication so that readers can directly access the content they are interested in. The same new format applies to the IPCC Reports as well.

YouTube 監警會頻道

《監警會頻道》是監警會在YouTube的官方頻道,近日亦新增多條電視劇《監警有道》宣傳片段、製作特輯及每集預告片,以影片來介紹監警會的職能及角色,務求進一步增加大眾對監警會的工作和投訴警察制度的認識。

Other new features include notifications on the home page of upcoming Open Meetings between the IPCC and CAPO. Clicking on the notification directs visitors to the meeting agenda and information on how to make reservations to observe the Open Meetings. At the bottom of the home page, the drop-down site map offers a clear overview of the various sections and sub-sections so that visitors can easily locate their target information.

New content has also been added to the website, such as photos and descriptions of the IPCC's engagement with various stakeholders, press events, and a full list of all the currently appointed IPCC Observers.

The new IPCC website is designed to be accessible to all members of the public, including those with disabilities and special needs. The IPCC is committed to ensuring that the new website complies with the World Wide Web Consortium (W3C) Web Content Accessibility Guidelines (WCAG) 2.0 Level AA requirements.

A mobile version has also been developed to enable the public to access information about the IPCC on smartphones and other mobile devices.

IPCC YouTube Channel

New videos have been uploaded on the IPCC Channel, the official channel of the IPCC on YouTube. These include a promotional clip for the *IPCC Files*, its "Making of" clip, and episode trailers. Through this online channel, the IPCC aims to further enhance public understanding of the IPCC's work and the complaints against police system with the use of videos.

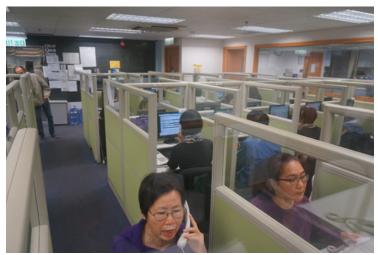

The survey was conducted by telephone interview on a random sample. There were 1,014 successful interviews with Hong Kong residents aged 18 or above.

此個案顯示監警會仔細審視一名投訴警察課人員處 理投訴的方法。個案更闡明投訴警察課人員在處理 投訴時,須明確地向投訴人説明各種可採用的投訴 處理方法,以確保投訴人有足夠資訊作出決定。

一名市民投訴警方,此投訴個案交由投訴警察課一 名女警長處理。其後,投訴人對該名女警長提出三 項指控,包括引導投訴人選擇一個簡便的方法處理 投訴【指控一:行為不當】、沒有按她要求及時安 排監警會觀察員出席會面【指控二:疏忽職守】, 以及沒有通知處理其案件的警察部門,她有新的資 料提供作重查案件的理據【指控三:疏忽職守】。 個案經調查後,投訴警察課把指控一分類為「無法 完全證明屬實」、指控二為「無法證實」、指控三 為「並無過錯」。

This case demonstrates that the IPCC is meticulous in scrutinising the actions taken by a CAPO officer towards a complainant when handling a complaint against the Police. It also illustrates the importance of CAPO clearly explaining to complainants all the options in handling a complaint, so that they could make an informed decision.

The complainant had lodged a complaint against the Police, which was handled by a Woman Sergeant (WSGT) of CAPO. Subsequently, the complainant lodged three allegations against the WSGT for inducing her to choose an option to deal with her complaint summarily [Allegation 1: Misconduct]; failing to promptly arrange for an IPCC Observer at her interview upon request [Allegation 2: Neglect of Duty], and failing to inform the police formation handling the review of her crime case that she had new information to provide [Allegation 3: Neglect of Duty]. After investigation, CAPO classified Allegation 1 as "Not Fully Substantiated", Allegation 2 as "Unsubstantiated" and Allegation 3 as "No Fault".

真實投訴個案 Real complaint case

監警會指涉事女警長並沒有正式知會監警會投訴 人要求會面時要有觀察員在場。另外,投訴人曾 多次表示就案件有新的資料可以提供,所以女警 長在通知有關警察部門投訴人要求重查案件時, 應要提及有新的資料。投訴警察課認同監警會的 見解,把指控二、三改為「無法完全證明屬實」 ,並建議對女警長作出訓諭。

個案背景

投訴人較早前曾就其舉報的「詐騙 | 案件向投訴警 察課投訴數名警員,個案由投訴警察課一名女警長 處理。

女警長透過電話錄音系統與投訴人跟進投訴個案。 在電話對話中,女警長向投訴人簡述她可以採用表 達不滿機制和透過簡便方式解決來處理投訴,然而 投訴人則多次要求投訴警察課進行全面調查。投訴 人更要求當女警長與她會面錄取口供時有監警會的 觀察員在場,但她後來才發現並沒有安排觀察員列 席會面。另外,投訴人就她先前舉報的「詐騙案」 有新的資料,故要求女警長通知負責其案件的警察 部門重新調查該案件,但她及後才得悉負責的警員 並不知道她是因為有新資料提供而要求重新調查。

投訴人隨即對該名女警長作出投訴,指女警長引導 她以簡便方式解決投訴【指控一:行為不當】;未 有根據她的要求,安排監警會觀察員出席會面【指 控二:疏忽職守】及沒有通知負責的警察部門她可 以提供新資料,以助重新調查詐騙案【指控三:疏 忽職守】。

投訴警察課的調查

經調查後,投訴警察課認為根據電話錄音系統的紀 錄,女警長沒有提出較合投訴人意願的全面調查投 訴選擇,但因沒有充足理據證實她是故意引導投訴 人,故把指控一分類為「無法完全證明屬實」。投 訴警察課把指控二分類為「無法證實」,因為沒 有證據證明或否定雙方所述有關投訴人要求女警長 知會監警會安排觀察員出席會面。對於女警長沒有

The IPCC observed that the WSGT had failed to properly notify the IPCC of the interview with the complainant, who had requested the presence of an IPCC Observer. Moreover, while informing the related police formation of the complainant's request for a review of her crime case, the WSGT should have mentioned that the complainant would provide new information, as the complainant had repeatedly emphasised that she had new information in hand. As such, IPCC suggested reclassifying Allegations 2 and 3 as "Not Fully Substantiated", which was agreed by CAPO. It was recommended that the WSGT be advised.

Case background

The complainant had previously lodged a complaint with CAPO against some police officers for mishandling a "Deception" case reported by her. A Woman Sergeant (WSGT) of CAPO was assigned to handle the complaint.

The WSGT contacted the complainant via the Telephone Recording System (TRS) to follow up on the complaint. During the telephone conversation, the WSGT only introduced the Expression of Dissatisfaction Mechanism and the Informal Resolution as options for dealing with her complaint, even though the complainant had expressed several times that she wanted her complaint to be fully investigated. Furthermore, the complainant requested an IPCC Observer to be present when the WSGT interviewed her to take a statement regarding the complaint. Nevertheless, the complainant later learned that no IPCC Observer had been arranged to attend the interview. Lastly, the complainant also requested to refer her "Deception" case to the relevant police formation for case review, and that she had some new information to provide. However, the complainant later found out that the crime case reviewing officer was not aware that she had new information to support her review request.

Subsequently, the complainant lodged an instant complaint against the WSGT for inducing her to choose an option to deal with her complaint summarily [Allegation 1: Misconduct]; failing to promptly arrange for an IPCC Observer to attend her interview upon request [Allegation 2: Neglect of Duty], and failing to inform the related police formation that she would provide new information for the case review [Allegation 3: Neglect of Duty].

CAPO's investigation

After investigation, CAPO classified Allegation 1 as "Not Fully Substantiated" because the TRS records revealed that the WSGT did not mention other options, including the Full Investigation option, which would have met the complainant's request. However, there was insufficient evidence to prove that she had the intention to induce the complainant to choose other options as alleged. CAPO classified Allegation 2 as "Unsubstantiated" as it lacked evidence to either prove or negate the either side's versions of events concerning

通知負責部門,投訴人可提供該詐騙案的新資料— 事,投訴警察課指投訴人沒有明確地提出指示,所 以女警長沒有過失,而指控三純屬一場誤會,故投 訴警察課把該指控分類為「並無過錯」。

監警會的觀察

監警會認同投訴警察課就指控一的調查結果。就指 控二而言,在女警長通知監警會有關會面時,投訴 警察課還未把個案列為須匯報投訴,故當時個案並 不在監警會觀察員計劃涵蓋範疇內。女警長當時只 通知監警會個案將會歸類為須匯報投訴。然而,在 個案被歸類為須匯報投訴後,女警長未有再通知監 警會。監警會認為女警長沒有及時通知會方,有一 宗須匯報投訴的投訴人要求安排觀察員出席會面。

監警會對指控三「並無過錯」的分類有所保留。會 方認為女警長告訴有關警察部門投訴人要求重新調 查案件時,應同時提及投訴人有新資料提供,以便 負責該案的警員能有效評估案情,加上投訴人已多 番強調她有新資料提供。

監警會就女警長有疏忽之嫌而提出質詢。經考慮 後,投訴警察課同意監警會的見解,並將指控二、 三的分類改為「無法完全證明屬實」。投訴警察課 建議對涉事女警長作出訓諭,但無需把此事記入其 分區報告檔案中。

監警會通過這宗個案的調查結果。

the WSGT's notifying the IPCC of the complainant's request for an IPCC Observer to attend the interview. CAPO did not find the WSGT at fault for not informing the related police formation that the complainant would provide new information for the crime case review, as the complainant had not explicitly made such a request. CAPO considered that the allegation was made out of misunderstanding, and thus classified Allegation 3 as "No Fault".

IPCC's observations

The IPCC agreed with CAPO's findings for Allegation 1. Regarding Allegation 2, when the WSGT notified the IPCC of the interview concerned, the complaint had yet to be categorised by CAPO as a Reportable Complaint (RC) and thus was not within the purview of the IPCC Observer Scheme. The WSGT merely called the IPCC to say the complaint would soon be categorised as an RC. However, after the complaint was categorised as an RC, no notification was sent to the IPCC by the WSGT. The IPCC was of the view that the WSGT had failed to notify the IPCC in a timely manner that an interview with the complainant of an RC, who had requested the presence of an IPCC Observer, had been scheduled.

The IPCC also had reservations concerning the "No Fault" classification of Allegation 3, holding the view that while informing the related police formation of the complainant's request for a case review, the WSGT should have mentioned that the complainant would provide new information so that the reviewing officer could assess the situation better, especially when the complainant had repeatedly emphasised that she had new information at hand.

The IPCC's view was relayed to CAPO by way of a query to revisit the alleged negligence on the part of the WSGT. After consideration, CAPO subscribed to the IPCC's view and reclassified Allegations 2 and 3 as "Not Fully Substantiated". CAPO recommended advising the WSGT without a Divisional Record File entry.

The IPCC endorsed CAPO's findings in this case.
