IPCC APPOINTS RICKY CHU AS NEW SECRETARY-GENERAL

The Independent Police Complaints Council (IPCC) today announced the appointment of Mr Ricky CHU Man-kin as its Secretary-General. He will join IPCC on 3 January 2011.

The appointment is made by IPCC under section 6 of the IPCC Ordinance (Cap. 604). As the Secretary-General of IPCC, he will lead a full-time Secretariat to assist Council Members in monitoring the handling and investigation of complaints by the Complaints Against Police Office, and in promoting the work of IPCC.

Mr CHU was selected by IPCC as the most suitable candidate following a head-hunting exercise conducted by an executive search firm.

Mr CHU is 56 years old. Prior to joining IPCC, Mr CHU was an Assistant Director of the Independent Commission Against Corruption (ICAC). In his 32 years of service in ICAC, he had been in charge of the two frontline investigation branches and various investigation groups including those responsible for Government Sector and Disciplinary Force corruption investigations. Throughout the years, Mr CHU had also represented ICAC in attending various international forums and sharing his experiences in anti-corruption work.
