IPCC Renders Full Support to Government's Vaccination Leave Arrangement

(HONG KONG – 31 May 2021) The Independent Police Complaints Council (IPCC) welcomes the Government's latest arrangement of "vaccination leave" for their employees after COVID-19 vaccination.

In response to the Government's appeal to support the "Early Vaccination for All" campaign, the IPCC announced that from 1 June until 31 August 2021, staff members will be entitled to one day "vaccination leave" after each vaccine dose received. For those who were vaccinated on or before 31 May, they will also be allowed to apply for one day of authorized absence that may be taken by 31 March 2022, for each dose already received. The IPCC encourages staff members to get vaccinated as soon as possible in order to build a protective barrier with the community and combat the COVID Virus together.
